



The Academy Athletic Eligibility

In order to meet CHSAA academic eligibility requirements, The Academy has selected to follow Plan A. Plan A states: During the period of participation, the student must be enrolled in courses which offer, in aggregate, a minimum of 2.5 Carnegie units of credit per semester and must not be failing more than the equivalent of one-half Carnegie unit of credit.

To put this in terms at The Academy, a student may not fail more than one class to remain eligible for participation. At The Academy we do a weekly eligibility, if a student fails more than one class they are ineligible the following week.

CHSAA states that if a student fails semester classes, they are not eligible until the regain date in the fall or in the spring.

The Academy has the Junior High follow eligibility only to the extent of the weekly reporting. The Junior High will NOT follow the semester guidelines.

Eligibility Expectations

Teachers will grade all class work in a timely fashion and report/post grades by **3:30 PM every Thursday**. Students and coaches will be notified of grades on Friday.

Failure for teachers to follow these expectations will result in disciplinary procedures, by administration, as outlined.

1st Offense – Warning and discussion with Assistant Principal / Athletic Director

2nd Offense – Write up by the Assistant Principal / Athletic Director, and a meeting to establish an action plan for the teacher.

3rd Offense – Meeting with the level Principal

4th Offense – Meeting with the Executive Director
